PROGRAMS AND SERVICES



EARLY CHILD CARE & EDUCATION PROGRAM:

The Child Care Program offers a daily developmental training program from 7:30 AM until 6:00 PM for children who require specialized program and therapies as well as those children who do not. Included is classroom instruction with trained staff, specialized therapies as recommended, and a nurse available as needed.

Emphasis is on preschool educational activities, perceptual motor, gross motor, fine motor, communication, cognition, self help and socialization skills. Children who are 24 months through six years of age are eligible to enroll. This program is licensed by Department of Health and a vendor for Division of Family Services.



ACCOMPLISHMENTS JULY 1, 1999-JUNE 30, 2000

- ◆ 128 children were enrolled (54 with disabilities, 70 without).
- ◆ All Child Care Teachers now have four year undergraduate degrees.
- ◆ The program was relicensed by the Department of Health.
- ◆ Creative Curriculum has been implemented in the Child Care classrooms and Developmental Therapy.
- ◆ The Early Education & Child Care Program was nationally accredited by CARF.
- ◆ Plans were finalized to remodel and expand the Child Care Center.



GOALS FOR JULY 1, 2000 -JUNE 30, 2001

- ◆ Expand Day Care license for children 6 weeks through 6 years of age.
- ◆ Continue to develop a consistent volunteer base.
- ◆ Continue to improve the qualifications of staff.
- ◆ Complete building remodeling and additions.
- ◆ Increase community awareness of children's needs and available services.





INFANT & TODDLER THERAPY PROGRAM:

Families who have children from birth to 36 months old and are recommended for Family Training services are referred to this program. The Infant Therapy program provides a team of professionals (Speech Therapist, Physical/Occupational Therapist, RN, and Psychologist) who work with the child's primary care giver enabling them to work effectively with their child. Direct therapy, evaluation, and counseling play an integral part of this program. Child and care giver may choose to come to the Center one day weekly for group and individual therapy or receive therapy in their home.

THERAPY & REHABILITATION SERVICES:

Evaluations and therapy services are provided by licensed and/or certified Psychologists, Physical Therapists, Developmental Therapists, Speech/Language Therapists, and Occupational Therapists. In addition, the psychologist will provide group and individual counseling for families as well as play therapy for the individual.

Evaluations consist of both formal and informal testing and are designed to determine strengths and needs with which an individual plan can be developed. The therapists provide direct therapy as well as develop home programs and provide family training as part of the plan and as recommended. In most cases a physician's order must accompany any referral of physical, occupational, or speech therapy or evaluations.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS JULY 1, 1999 - JUNE 30, 2000

- ◆156 children and their families received therapy services.
- ◆74 families received services through our Home Visit and natural environment services.
- ◆Home visit and natural environment services were expanded.
- ◆343 evaluations were completed and the procedure for evaluations was strengthened and turnaround time decreased.
- ◆18,702 sessions of therapy were provided.
- ◆45 children and families were served in Infant Therapy.
- ◆400 sessions of individual/group counseling were held for families.
- ◆Children in both Therapy Programs reflected progress.
- ◆A procedure was put into place to send physicians regular progress notes and updates.
- ◆Plans were finalized to remodel the Therapy space.
- ◆The Therapy Program was nationally accredited by CARF.



GOALS FOR JULY 1, 2000 -JUNE 30, 2001

- ◆Complete building remodeling and additions.
- ◆Expand therapy services within as well as outside the Springfield area.
- ◆Increase community awareness of children's needs and available services.
- ◆Ensure that all Therapy Staff will initiate/receive Early Intervention Credentials.
- ◆Increase enrollment by integrating all therapy into a "natural environment" as defined by First Steps.
- ◆Monitor program costs and billable hours to ensure both effectiveness as well as efficiency in services.
- ◆Continue to improve and the turn around time for evaluations.
- ◆Continue to review the need for services in other counties.





COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRAM:

The Community Service programs offer two services for individuals who are referred by the family or Service Coordination agency. The services are Habilitation Programming and Personal Assistance. Habilitation Programming offers individuals the opportunity to learn and practice skills in the community including functional academics, recreation, community awareness, self direction and use of community resources. Personal Assistant services provide assistance in the home to maintain or improve personal health and independence.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS JULY 1, 1999-JUNE 30, 2000

- ◆ 166 individuals were served in community habilitation services.
- ◆ Remodeling of Greene & Christian County Adult Services Buildings interior has been completed.
- ◆ Annual Surveys of consumers, families, and community integration sites were returned for a 35% rate with 100% indicating satisfaction with the program.
- ◆ Progress was made by individuals in all three counties.
- ◆ Regular staff meetings have been scheduled to ensure consistent and effective staff communication.
- ◆ Procedures were implemented to provide parents and guardians with regular feedback and communication.
- ◆ The Community Integration Program was nationally accredited by CARF.

GOALS FOR JULY 1, 2000 -JUNE 30, 2001

- ◆ Complete exterior remodeling of the Greene County Adult Services Building.
- ◆ Develop proposals regarding transportation in Taney County.
- ◆ Expand services in Taney County based on needs assessment, ie: summer & after school programs, therapy services, etc.
- ◆ Continue to increase the percent of people receiving individualized services based on needs and preferences.
- ◆ Expand community awareness and marketing in all three counties, but especially Christian County.

COMMUNITY EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM:

The Employment Program is designed to assist eligible individuals obtain and maintain gainful employment through a Job Coach Model. Individuals who are over 16 and referred through agencies such as Vocational Rehabilitation and Rehabilitation for the Blind are eligible for this program. A functional assessment of vocational interests, preferences, and skills is completed. A job placement is made in a position which matches the assessed information and for which the applicant is qualified. Job Coaches provide training, support, and intervention in the work place to ensure a successful placement. Both individual and group models are available for employment applicants. Programs are available in Greene and Taney Counties.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS JULY 1, 1999-JUNE 30, 2000

- ◆ 105 individuals were served.
- ◆ 78% of the employer surveys were returned with 98% indicating satisfaction.
- ◆ The Summer Youth Employment service was provided in Taney and Greene Counties.
- ◆ The Business Advisory Committee was redesigned.
- ◆ Additional training in contract bidding and time studies was completed.
- ◆ A plan was put into place and implemented to expand referral agencies awareness.
- ◆ Surveys of Vocational Rehabilitation Counselors and local employers were completed prior to developing a proposal for the Employment Lab.
- ◆ Additional work crew sites were developed to meet individual needs.
- ◆ Employment Services was redesigned with program staff and support staff assigned.
- ◆ The Employment Services Program was nationally accredited by CARF.

GOALS FOR JULY 1, 2000 - JUNE 30, 2001

- ◆ Implement a marketing plan in all counties.
- ◆ Expand summer employment opportunities for youth in all counties.
- ◆ Expand job opportunities for individuals with more challenging job placement needs.
- ◆ Market the employment lab services which are designed to provide assessment and short term, intense training in preparation for job placement or career moves.





ADULT DAY CENTER SERVICES:

The program is designed to assist older persons or those with developmental disabilities to maintain and retain skills of independence while participating in a stimulating, safe, and interactive environment. Scheduled activities include music, games, dancing, mild exercises (with physician approval), crafts, social activities, and quiet/leisure activities. Activities are based on an individual's interests, choices, and needs. Programs available in Greene and Christian Counties.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS JULY 1, 1999-JUNE 30, 2000

- ◆ Greene & Christian County Adult Day Centers were licensed and served 51.
- ◆ Interior remodeling in Greene & Christian Counties was completed.
- ◆ Procedures were implemented to provide parents and guardians with regular feedback and communication.
- ◆ Consistent staff meetings have been scheduled to ensure consistent and effective staff communication.



GOALS FOR JULY 1, 2000-JUNE 30, 2001

- ◆ Expand Greene & Christian County Adult Day Centers to full capacity through marketing.

TECHNOLOGY & LEARNING CENTER (TLC) SERVICES:

The Technology & Learning Center Services are planned in Greene and Taney Counties and will provide several Learning Labs which utilize a curriculum based on several levels of individual needs. This may range from individuals who are very dependent and require a great deal of intervention and tutoring to those who are self directed and need only general direction and instructions. Individuals may choose to use the Tech Center in conjunction with other programs such as community service, employment services, and Day Center services.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS JULY 1, 1999-JUNE 30, 2000

- ◆ Technology & Learning Center concept proposal was originated and accepted.
- ◆ A screening tool for TLC was developed.
- ◆ Greene County Technology Learning (TLC) Center was designed, remodeled & opened.
- ◆ Taney County Board for Developmental Disabilities approved a proposal to remodel TLC.



- ◆ The Technology Learning Center was nationally accredited by CARF.

GOALS FOR JULY 1, 2000-JUNE 30, 2001

- ◆ Recruit and train staff in the Technology Centers.
- ◆ Implement screening tools and curriculum for TLC.
- ◆ Expand services in Taney County based on needs assessment (i.e., summer or after school programs, therapy, etc.)
- ◆ Complete building remodeling in Taney County.
- ◆ Open Technology Center in Taney County.
- ◆ Develop contacts to expand referral sources for Technology & Learning Centers.
- ◆ Increase marketing for the Adult Day Centers and Technology Learning Centers in Greene & Christian County.
- ◆ Develop proposals regarding transportation in Taney County.

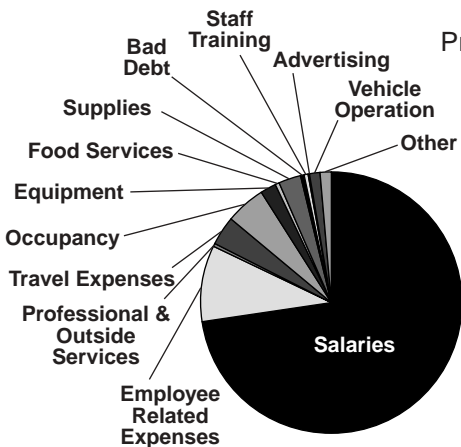
