# Early Child Care & Education Program

The Child Care Program offers a daily developmental training program from 7:30 AM until 6:00 PM for children who require specialized program and therapies as well as those children who do not. Included is classroom instruction with trained staff,

specialized therapies as recommended, and a full time nurse on staff. Emphasis is on preschool educational activities, perceptual motor, gross motor, fine motor, communication, cognition, self help and socialization skills. Children who are six weeks through six years of age are eligible to enroll. This program is licensed by Department of Health, a vendor for Division of Family Services and nationally accredited.



## ACCOMPLISHMENTS JULY 1, 2001 - JUNE 30, 2002

- 190 children were enrolled (63 with disabilities, 127 without).
- Added outside door security and video cameras in each classroom.
- The program was relicensed by the Department of Health with licensing capacity at 130.
- Creative Curriculum has been implemented in the Child Care classrooms with one teacher certified as a trainer.
- Six additional classrooms for infants, toddlers and two year olds were licensed.
- Partnership finalized with Early Head Start(EHS) for 16 spaces allocated to EHS.
- Building remodeling and additions to the Family Center were completed.

## GOALS FOR JULY 1, 2002 - JUNE 30, 2003

- Remodel three additional classrooms.
- Continue to develop a consistent volunteer base.
- Continue to improve the qualifications of staff.
- Increase community awareness of children's needs and available services.
- Implement PROCARE software and program for improved accounting and tracking.

# Therapy & Rehabilitation Services



Evaluations and therapy services are provided by licensed and/or certified Psychologists, Physical Therapists, Developmental Therapists, Speech/Language Therapists, Occupational Therapists and an RN. In addition, the psychologist will provide group and individual counseling for families as well as play therapy for the child.



Evaluations consist of both formal and informal testing and are designed to determine strengths and needs with which an individual plan can be developed.



The therapists provide direct therapy as well as develop home programs and provide family training as part of the plan and as recommended. In most cases a physician's order must accompany any referral of physical, occupational, or speech therapy or evaluations. This program provides services approved by First Steps, is accredited by CARF and approved by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education.

---

## ACCOMPLISHMENTS JULY 1, 2001 - JUNE 30, 2002

- 223 families received services through our Home Visit and natural environment services.
- Home Visit and natural environment services were expanded.
- 414 evaluations were completed and the procedure for evaluations was strengthened and turnaround time decreased.
- 19,082 sessions of therapy were provided.
- 205 sessions of individual/group counseling were held for families.
- Average progress was measured at 55%.
- Progress notes and updates were sent routinely to physicians.
- Remodeling of the therapy rooms was completed.
- 57% of evaluations were mailed within 7 days, 100% within 23 days.



---

## GOALS FOR JULY 1, 2002 - JUNE 30, 2003

- Increase community awareness of children's needs and available services.
- Completely integrate all therapy services in the "natural environment" as defined by First Steps.
- Monitor program costs and billable hours to ensure both effectiveness as well as efficiency in services.
- Continue to improve the turn around time for evaluations.
- Continue to review the need for services in other counties.

## What is a Developmental Disability?

Developmental disability is a broad term that may include cerebral palsy, mental retardation, autism, epilepsy, and a host of other lesser known or unnamed physically and/or mentally challenging conditions. Developmental disabilities originate before the age of 22 and may be expected to continue indefinitely.

## What is a Developmental Delay?

A developmental delay simply means that an individual, usually an infant or child, is not progressing through the stages of development at a satisfactory rate. They are, for whatever reason, "behind" others their age in development. Not all children with delays will have difficulty later in life. Early diagnosis and therapy is essential.



# Community Service Program



The Community Service programs offer three services for individuals who are referred by the family or Service Coordination agency. The services are Community Integration, Technology & Learning Center (TLC) and Personal Assistance. Community Integration offers individuals the opportunity to learn and practice skills in the community including functional academics, recreation, community awareness, self direction and use of community resources. Personal Assistant services provide assistance in the home to maintain or improve personal health and independence. The TLC services provide learning labs, which utilize a curriculum based on several levels of individual needs. These services are approved by the Dept. of Mental Health and accredited by CARF.

---

## ACCOMPLISHMENTS JULY 1, 2001 - JUNE 30, 2002

- 140 individuals were served in community habilitation services.
- Remodeling of the Taney County Adult Services Building interior was completed.
- Progress was made by individuals in all three counties.
- Parents and guardians were provided with regular feedback and communication.

---

## GOALS FOR JULY 1, 2002 - JUNE 30, 2003

- Complete exterior remodeling of the Greene County Adult Services Building.
- Develop proposals regarding transportation in Taney County.
- Remodel interior and upgrade equipment in Technology Learning Center.
- Refine the screening tools and curriculum used in the Technology Learning Center.
- Expand community awareness and marketing in all three counties, but especially Christian County.
- Implement steps to improve program efficiency.
- Develop and implement a staff recruitment plan.

# Community Employment Program

The Employment Program is designed to assist eligible individuals obtain and maintain gainful employment through a Job Coach Model. Individuals who are over 16 and referred through agencies such as Vocational Rehabilitation and



Rehabilitation for the Blind are eligible for this program. A functional assessment of vocational interests, preferences, and skills is completed. A job placement is made in a position which matches the assessed information and for which the applicant is qualified. Job Coaches provide training, support, and intervention in the work place to ensure a successful placement. Both individual and group models are available for employment applicants. Programs are available in Greene and Taney Counties.



---

## ACCOMPLISHMENTS JULY 1, 2001 - JUNE 30, 2002

- 125 individuals were served.
- 70% of the employer surveys were returned with 89% indicating satisfaction.
- The Summer Youth Employment service was provided in Taney County.
- The Employment Lab was initiated.
- A plan was put into place to expand referral agencies' awareness.

---

## GOALS FOR JULY 1, 2002 - JUNE 30, 2003

- Implement a marketing plan in all counties.
- Expand summer employment opportunities for youth in all counties.
- Expand job opportunities for individuals with more challenging job placement needs.
- Market the employment lab services which are designed to provide assessment and short term, intense training in preparation for job placement or career moves.
- Upgrade evaluation tools for vocational assessment.
- Improve program efficiency.

# Adult Day Center Services



The program is designed to assist older persons or those with developmental disabilities to maintain and retain skills of independence while participating in a stimulating, safe, and interactive environment. Scheduled activities include music, games, dancing, mild exercises (with physician approval), crafts, social activities, and quiet/leisure activities. Activities are based on an individual's interests, choices, and needs. Programs are available in Greene, Christian and Taney Counties.

---

## ACCOMPLISHMENTS JULY 1, 2001 - JUNE 30, 2002

- Greene & Christian County Adult Day Centers were licensed and served 66.
- Interior remodeling in Taney County was completed and licensed by the Division of Health & Senior Services.
- Greene & Christian County Adult Day Centers were relicensed by the Division of Health & Senior Services.
- Contract was developed to ensure nursing substitutes.

---

## GOALS FOR JULY 1, 2002 - JUNE 30, 2003

- Evaluate potential of meal preparation onsite in Taney County.
- Implement marketing plans to increase awareness and referrals in Christian and Taney County.
- Increase access to equipment and materials, such as computers and software.
